WHAT IS CONSTRUCTION TECHNOLOGY?

Enter a career in a field that is growing markedly in popularity and demand: residential or commercial construction. Our program provides a mix of general studies, technical education, theory, and hands-on experiences. Learn how to read and interpret construction blueprints and estimate material and time requirements to construct a building with the use of handbooks, spreadsheets, and prevailing wage tables. Skills acquired progress from floor, wall, and roof framing to exterior and interior finishes.

The Construction Technology program is reinforced with writing, math, and communication skills required to successfully lead a team in the construction trades. Our program partners with non-profit entities in Butte to help our students learn the construction trade and give something back to the community. Projects range in variety and level of difficulty from siding, framing, and roofing for Habitat for Humanity to erecting an addition to the Kiwanis Sunshine Camp. We are working with the Butte Community Ice Center making upgrades that include metal wainscoting, siding, and new custom-built lockers.
