HOTEL RESERVATIONS

- ◆ A block of rooms have been reserved for Fire Assay Course participants at the **Best Western Butte Plaza Inn**.
- ◆ A special rate of \$80.00/USD not including tax, per room, per night has been obtained. Please ask for Melissa Bolton, Director of Sales at 1-800-543-5814 (U.S. & Canada only) for room reservations and she will be happy to assist you . Please mention the **CAMP/MONTANA TECH-FIRE ASSAY SHORT COURSE** to obtain their special State room rate. Please visit their website at www.bestwestern.com/butteplazainn for the Hotel information only. Melissa has asked to **not book** your room on-line but call her directly instead.
- ◆ All these rooms are non-smoking. Please let the Hotel know if you do smoke as there is another set of rooms available.

- ◆ Business services available and free shuttle provided to and from the Hotel.

TRANSPORTATION

- ◆ Butte's Bert Mooney Airport (BTM) services Butte and surrounding areas. Other Montana airports and approximate driving distances from Butte include: Helena - 1 hour drive; Bozeman - 1.5 hour drive; Missoula - 2 hour drive; Billings - 3 hour drive; Great Falls - 2.5 hour drive.
- ◆ The Butte Plaza Inn is approximately 3 miles from the Butte airport and about 5 miles from Montana Tech. The Hotel will provide free transportation so please call at the airport courtesy phone for pickup to the Hotel when you arrive from your flight.
- ◆ Hertz, Avis, and Budget rental car companies operate directly out of the airport.
- ◆ **Note:** If renting a car you must park in designated "**B**" Lots on campus.
- ◆ The Hotel provides free shuttle service and will provide rides to Montana Tech. We also provide bus service to Deer Lodge and to the mine locations for no extra charge.

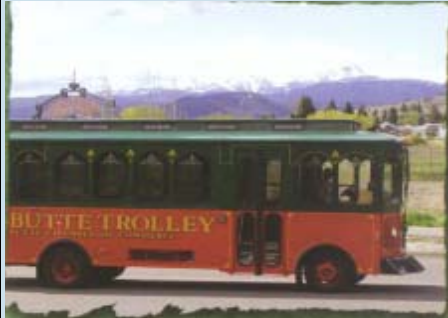
- ◆ Meet in Hotel Lobby, Hotel Shuttle will provide transportation to Mining Museum behind MT Tech.

Lady of the Rockies Tour

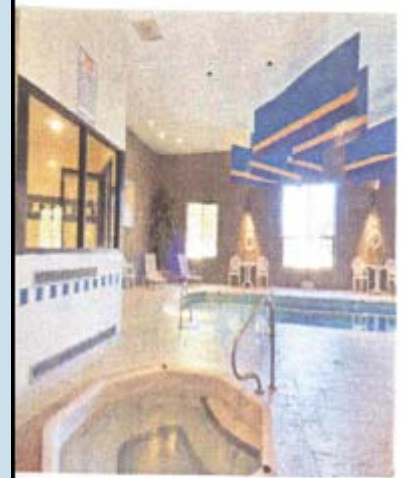


Our Lady of the Rockies...
