CDL APPLICTION / STUDENT AGREEMENT

Highlands College of Montana Tech is proud to offer a State of Montana approved program to prepare a driver trainee for their Commercial Driver's License and is a registered training provider under the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration. Driver applications must obtain training from a training provider listed on the Training Provider Registry. The program will be held four-five times a year and will require a six-eight-week time commitment.

Theory: Students should be prepared to read the Montana Commercial Driver License Manual, complete modules and practice exams in Moodle, and demonstrate their understating of the material by achieving an overall minimum score of 80 percent in the online J.J. Keller Curriculum, "Entry Level Driver Training: Obtaining A CDL". Students must obtain their Commercial Learner's Permit (CLP) before they may start their over-the-road driving.

Behind-The-Wheel: Performance evaluations will be conducted by the CDL instructors for the behind-the-wheel Range and Public Road. The instructors will assess each driver trainee's individual performance to ensure they are proficient of the BTW portions of curricula before allowing them to schedule the skills tests.
