M.S. TECHNICAL COMMUNICATION

In addition to the Graduate school requirements, applicants to the Master's in Technical Communication are asked to complete the following:

1. **A writing sample**, preferably an example of a technical document. This sample may have been prepared for a class or in an employment/volunteer setting.
2. **An example of production work**, if you have one. If you've produced a brochure, a manual, booklet or a video, please allow us to view it. Describe the process used to produce the piece you are demonstrating.

3. **A statement of purpose**

Whatever your primary purpose, please elaborate on it. What do you want to contribute and how will you accomplish that purpose? How does pursuit of this degree relate to your goals?

4. **Present ideas for a major project**

If all elements fall into place, what will you pursue as a six-credit major project? If you have several ideas, list each one. Sketch a plan; identify potential resources; share your dreams!

Identification of a possible project now does not commit you to that project. It is important, however, that you continue to reflect on a project during the weeks ahead. Having "the end in mind" clearly assures satisfaction and success in this program.
