PUBLIC LECTURE: CRAIG M. BLEILE

Montana Tech's Public Lecture Series will host Craig Bleile from the Naval Undersea Warfare Center (NUWC) in Keyport, Washington on **Wednesday**, **November 2**, **2022** at 4:00 pm in the Copper Lounge. His talk is titled, "The US Navy in an Era of Great Power Competition." As the US Navy exits the era of the Global War on Terror and refocuses on Great Power Competition, there are many implications related to Force Structure and the application of emerging technology. This talk will explore the coming changes from the viewpoint of a navy technologist.

Mr. Craig M. Bleile works for the Naval Undersea Warfare Center (NUWC) at Keyport, Washington. His portfolio includes all Science, Technology, Research and Development and Experimentation at NUWC Keyport. Past tours have included Science Advisor for the Navy Warfare Development Command where he co-authored key advanced warfighting concepts. Other Science Advisor tours have included Fleet Cyber Command, Naval Information Forces Command and 5th Fleet in Bahrain. His areas of expertise include Amphibious Warfare, Strike Warfare, Information Warfare, and Undersea Warfare. Mr. Bleile received his Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering from Boston University and a Master of Science in Systems Engineering from the Naval Postgraduate School (NPS). He is currently working on completing his Ph.D. in Information Science at NPS.
