STUDENT EMPLOYEE OF THE YEAR AWARDS

Montana Tech is participating in the Student Employee of the Year awards. Each spring, we coordinate a selection process and choose a Student Employee of the Year (SEOTY) to recognize the outstanding contributions and achievements of students who work while attending college. The SEOTY process begins with supervisors nominating outstanding student employees at the institutional level. In order to be eligible, the student employee must have worked a minimum of 6 months during the 2023-2024 academic year. Only undergraduate student employees are eligible for consideration.

Supervisors will nominate students by submitting a letter **(two-page maximum)** with the following requirements:

Briefly describe why you are submitting this student for recognition.

- Briefly outline your student employee's accomplishments over this past year and/or how they have contributed to the work place.
- How does this student exhibit National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) competencies in their position? Please provide specific examples.
- Closing statement.

Supervisors will submit a cover letter with the following information: student name, student's email address, supervisor name, supervisor's email, student job title, and department where student position is held.

All submission letters are due to Ice Demus at studentemployment@mtech.edu by 12:00 pm on **March 1**. Submission letters must be sent as a PDFs. Submission letters are not to exceed two pages.

2024-2025 FAFSA & UPDATES

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is open and ready to complete for students looking to apply for financial aid for the 2024-2025 academic year. If you have not done so, now is the time to get your FAFSA completed! Here's what you need to know about the timeline:

- The FASFA is available at studentaid.gov/fafsa.
- Montana Tech's priority deadline to apply for financial aid is March 1st. *
- We anticipate the University will receive your information from the Department of Education in March.
- Your information will be uploaded and processed by the University in April.
- We anticipate sending financial aid offer notifications in early May.
- * Students who complete the FAFSA after March 1st will be processed on a rolling basis.
