CAREER PATHS

The nursing profession is the nation's largest healthcare field, with over 3.1 million registered nurses across the country. RNs make up one of the largest segments of the U.S. workforce and are among the highest-paying professions in healthcare.

Montana Tech's Sherry Lesar School of Nursing graduates are highly sought after and find careers in diverse settings, including hospitals, clinics, and other healthcare facilities nationwide.

The demand for registered nurses in Montana is strong. The state is projected to see a 15% growth rate in the need for RNs over the next decade, significantly higher than the national average. This robust job market, coupled with competitive salaries and a lower cost of living, makes Montana an attractive place for a nursing career.
