Please use the following checklist as a guide to make sure that you complete *all* of the steps required to graduate. This sheet is for your information only and does *not* need to be turned in with your application.

- Meet with your advisor and complete:
  - Application for Graduation
  - Department Specific Curriculum WorksheetYour application is not complete until you submit these forms (completed with signatures) and pay your \$79 graduation fee.
  
- Make sure that you've obtained *all* of the required signatures:
  - Student
  - Advisor
  - Department Head
  - Academic Dean (*School of Mines & Engineering only*)
  - Business Office – the Business Office will sign off once you've paid the \$79 graduation fee.
  
- Complete MAPP test and record the test date on page 2 of the application for degree (*north campus students only*)
  
- Complete the graduate survey located at <http://www.mtech.edu/career/students/graduatequestionnaire.htm> .

Please be sure to complete all of the above steps prior to submitting your application for degree. **Incomplete applications will NOT be accepted.**

Caps and Gowns will be available at the Bookstore about 3-4 weeks prior to graduation, so be sure to watch for emails from the Bookstore in the Spring!!!

\***Fall** grad applications are due in April (the semester before)

\***Spring** grad applications are due in November (the semester before)
