

Colstrip Power Plant / Northern Cheyenne Scholarship Announcement for Fall Semester 2019 Deadline for Application: April 10, 2019

The Northern Cheyenne Tribal Education Department is accepting applications for two (2) scholarships provided the by the Colstrip Power Plant operated by Talen Energy. Scholarship applicants need to be enrolled in or planning to enroll in Engineering, Power Plant Technology, Electrical and Instrumentation Technology, Business, Welding, Environmental Science, Chemistry, or Computer Technology. The scholarship covers tuition, books, subsistence and some travel expenses.

Requirements:

- 1. Must be an enrolled member of the Northern Cheyenne Tribe
- 2. Must have a High School Diploma or GED
- 3. Must be seeking first Bachelor's Degree or first Technical Associates Degree
- 4. Must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0
- 5. Must be accepted to or enrolled in a regional public institution

Application Procedure:

Colstrip Power Plant follows the Northern Cheyenne Tribal Education Department application process. Applications can be obtained from the Tribal Education Department or on the Northern Cheyenne Nation website (http://www.cheyennenation.com/education.html).

All applications must include:

- 1. An essay which includes information on career goals and explains why you think you should be awarded the Colstrip Power Plant scholarship.
- 2. Provide official High School transcripts or GED scores and official college transcripts.
- 3. Provide a copy of Northern Cheyenne certification of enrollment.
- 4. Provide three (3) letters of recommendations (no immediate family members).
