

Secondary Nursing Application Process – Spring 2026

The Sherry Lesar School of Nursing admits 40 students each semester to a clinical seat. However, in the event there are low applicant numbers in the spring for fall admission, a secondary process may be enacted.

Secondary application process:

This process is applicable to any student who has met the eligibility requirements to apply to the Sherry Lesar School of Nursing.

Student capacity

- The Director of Nursing will make the decision to enact this process **no later** than June 1st.
- The number of available seats will be determined by the number of applicants who accept placement during the primary application process.
- Secondary applicants may use any eligible TEAS score earned within the academic year.
- The applicant may choose to retake the TEAS exam one additional time. If the student chooses to retake the TEAS exam, the most recent score will be accepted for application.
- A TEAS exam review session will be offered to any student wishing to retake the TEAS exam and is strongly advised.

Additional Secondary Application Details

- Prerequisite courses must be completed by August 9th, 2026 to be eligible for the secondary application process.
- The secondary application process will have **no impact** on applicants from the primary application process who have accepted placement by June 28th.
- The secondary application process targets pre-nursing students who have an established relationship and have been communicating with the nursing department.
- Any student who applies through the secondary application process and has met all nursing department application requirements except completion of NRS 107, may be admitted to the program with enrollment into NRS 107 along with nursing classes in Fall 2026. Students who are admitted into the program and enrolled in NRS 107 must pass all nursing courses and NRS 107 with a C+ or higher in order to progress through the program.

Important Dates: secondary application process

- For those students wanting a second opportunity to take the TEAS test during the summer semester, the TEAS test is scheduled May 20th from 8:00-12:00pm. The TEAS test must be paid for (\$70) in advance with the business office and the receipt submitted to the Nursing Department. - Secondary Applications will be due by June 26, 2026, no later than 4pm.
- Selected applicants from secondary process will be notified **no later** than August 16, 2026. (Earlier notification may occur depending on approval of any final summer grades.)
